Meet Sandy, an Energetic Puppy Whose Friendliness Almost Cost Her Life

It was an ordinary autumn morning when Joanne brought her 7-month old Golden-doodle for her daily romp in the open field that has become her town's unofficial "off-leash" area. Sandy was happily playing with her canine pals when she noticed a family doing yard work nearby. The friendly dog took off running toward them to say hello, ignoring Joanne's frantic pleas to stop. As she crossed the street, Sandy was hit by a car.

So great was the impact that Joanne first thought Sandy was surely dead. As she raced to her fallen puppy, she saw that Sandy was in shock and shaking badly, but alive!



With a neighbor's help, Joanne transported Sandy to Red Bank Veterinary Hospital, where an emergency team was standing by to rush the critically injured dog to the doctors who would assess the scope of her injuries. They determined that Sandy had suffered two broken legs and severe pulmonary contusions.

Seeing Joanne in the agonizing situation of desperately wanting to approve the surgeries and treatment her dog needed, but knowing her family was unable to bear the cost, Sandy's doctor told her about the Save U.S. Pets Foundation. Joanne told her husband, Stephen, and children, Erin, Christopher, Caitlin and Colin; "If the Foundation is willing to help fund Sandy's medical costs, they must think she has a pretty good chance of making it!"

Within an hour of completing the application process, Joanne was notified that her request for financial assistance was approved. Her heart filled with joy – Sandy would be saved!

Today, the resilient dog shows no physical signs from the serious accident and her doctors say she should have no lasting effects from her injuries.

Why and How We Help Save Pet's Lives

Knowing first hand of the need to establish a source of financial assistance for families, like that of Sandy, who otherwise could not provide lifesaving care for their pets, a compassionate group of veterinary professionals formed what became the Save U.S. Pets Foundation. Despite the generosity of veterinarians who often subsidize vital care, thousands of people and their pets face economic barriers to life-saving medical treatment every year. Regrettably, too many times euthanasia is the chosen alternative.

- Through a participating veterinarian, pet owners whose circumstances meet the Save U.S. Pets Foundation's criteria are eligible for grant funds.
- A grant review committee, structured to act quickly in emergency situations, works within specific guidelines to determine qualification.
- All funds are distributed directly to the treating veterinarian chosen by the pet owner.

The Save U.S. Pets Foundation is committed to working diligently and passionately until the day when no pet is denied lifesaving medical care because of an owner's inability to pay.
